- The Senate voted to require all organization, including the student government as a whole, to complete elections by April 1st. This was done in part to provide more structure, resources, and training for officer transitions and organizational continuity. There will be officer transition training on April 4, 5, 6. In line with this change, they also moved allocations back, which will take place April 21-23.
- A resolution was introduced at Student Senate by the Finance Committee that would no longer all travel requests to be made by student organizations at allocations; instead, if the resolution passes they would be required to make travel requests at CEA (Conference, Event, Activity) dates during the academic year of travel, with more emphasis at allocations on funding campus programming and club functions on campus and within the community.
- Student Senate voted to fund \$2,000 for a one-time cost to have a custom stole builder web site designed for graduation regalia. The site allows students to order custom PSU stoles embroidered with a variety of options that detail their student experience.
- CEA requests were granted for three groups to travel to conferences. The last round of CEA requests for this semester will be heard on April 2 and are due to the Student Senate Finance Committee by Thursday March 30th.
- Early last month Student Senate hosted a very successful safe celebration of the Super Bowl with Sodexo in Prospect, which had about 700 attendees. The also hosted a successful Ski Day at Waterville with support from PACE and club sports, and over 1,700 attendees and many activities in the Village as well for non-skiers and non-snowboarders.
- Senate has discussed constituency concerns regarding the flood, campus and town lighting (in particular at cross walks), town noise ordinance policy, off campus gatherings, and texting notifications.
- In addition to their regular internal and external committee involvement, members of Senate have been actively working on two working group committees this semester, a community forum speak out series and a group exploring opportunities for a campus pub.
